TMSS Medical College At a Glance

TMSS Medical College was established by TMSS in 2008. From a modest beginning, TMSS has grown into one of the largest non-government developed organization in Bangladesh. For producing a dignified and efficient medical professionals TMSS Health Sector established the medical college on 26th June 2008. Through the dedicated and tremendous efforts this institution becomes one of the leading Non-Government Medical Colleges of the country.

It is located in the northern part of the country and near historical ancient city of Pundranagar, now Mahasthangar, Bogura. The scenic beauty of the campus is breath taking and is easily accessible by different routes from different parts of the country and overseas as well.

Being a Non-Government institute it possess some uniqueness in operating the MBBS & BDS Courses. A bunch of committed, student friendly & experienced faculty members and staffs of this institution are working together for providing quality education. To maintain the highest professional standards in every discipline, the national guidelines and tools for Quality Assurance Scheme (QAS) have been implemented from 2014 and a well-planned Medical Education Unit has been established which is another uniqueness of this medical college. The Medical Education Unit works for maintaining the standards of teaching, skills assessment/evaluation and others aspects of students' well beings. For listening the students' voice a feedback mechanism exist where student can give their feedback regularly. A well versed foreign desk is also working for foreign students to help them in admission procedure, visa processing and to look after their total well-being.

Keeping the overall vision and mission 850 bedded tertiary care hospital came in to existence named TMSS Medical College & Rafatullah Community Hospital (TMC&RCH) in the same

campus of TMC and serves as teaching & clinical hospital for the students and provide all the specialized modern medical services.

The TMC provides separate hostel facilities for international & local, male & female students to maintain dicipline. TMC central library contains a huge number of text and reference books, local and foreign medical journals, newspapers, rare periodicals, research works, etc. The computer laboratory with internet connection is free for students and teachers. There has a e-library facility for students.

Students have an enormous opportunity here for co-curricular activities. They can enjoy festivity and gain knowledge through regular performance of annual cultural competition, debate, sports, picnic, study tour, excursion, observe national days and some off-the-cuff events.

In BDS course, Five Batches of students have qualified as doctors & also completed internship training and the Sixth Batch is appearing Final Professional Examination in TMSS Medical College & Rafatullah Community Hospital (TMC & RCH), Dental Unit.

Why TMSS Medical College is the right place for medical education?

TMC has significant faculty and human resources, physical and financial resources. TMC has managed to create and maintain an ideal environment for students to acquire knowledge.

Faculty

TMC faculty comprises a unique blend of teachers, researchers and practitioners. The faculty consists of a distinguished body of scholars with proven teaching and research excellence. Many have doctoral degrees from universities abroad. Many are postgraduate degree holders and professionals with varied experiences. Visiting faculty members from different Government and Non-Government Medical Colleges from home and abroad bring diversity and richness in the learning environment.

Teacher-Student Ratio

The teacher student ratio of TMC is 1:10. An optimum teacher student ratio can make a substantial impact on students' education. The smaller the class size, the more significant the benefits are for individualized – and personalized–attention and support, resulting in greater accountability and involvement in the classroom as well as an enhanced learning experience. Small group teaching is one of the outstanding features of TMC.

Visiting Faculties from Home & Abroad

TMC has the provision to invite renowned faculty members, reputed specialist doctors, visiting professors from abroad to arrange conference, seminar, webinar & workshops in TMC. Thus the students of TMC get the opportunity to have more comprehensive knowledge of the inner workings of the professional world. Having experienced and distinguished specialists teach in an academic setting can therefore transform students into capable and up-to-date graduates.

Teacher's Dormitory and Examiner Lounge

TMC has modern and well furnished teacher's dormitory facilities. Visiting faculties & dignitaries of home & abroad may find themselves at ease during their visit and stay at TMC. There is also separate examiner lounge for examiners.

Spacious and Scenic Campus

The campus of TMC is located in tranquil and picturesque surroundings of a beautiful village named Thengamara which is six kilometers north to Bogura town. The campus has excellent communication links to all parts of the country as it is situated beside the Bogura–Rangpur highway. TMC has one of the most spacious campus among the non-government medical colleges of Bangladesh with total land area of 10.69 acres of which Medical College has 9 acres of land and Hospital has 1.69 acres of land. The seven-storied academic building has total floor space of 2,92,000 sq. ft. The 19 storied TMSS Medical College Hospital building has 1000 beds accommodation facilities of which 850 beds are approved for bedside teaching and learning for clinical students. Total floor space of hospital building is 7,20,000 sq. ft.



Security

TMC provides a safe and secure environment for all members of the TMC community, including students, faculty, staff and campus visitors. The whole campus is under surveillance of CCTV camera. Besides sufficient number of security guards are present in different areas of the campus 24 hours a day. TMC works tirelessly to ensure safety and security of the campus, where students can feel comfortable and safe.

Classrooms and Lecture Gallery Complex



TMC has classrooms of various sizes, ranging from regular ones that can hold 30-50 seats, to large ones (Lecture gallery) with a capacity of 250-500 seats. Smaller classrooms are used for the purpose of tutorial and practical classes, small group teaching etc. Each classroom is equipped with multimedia projectors, overhead projectors and Wi-Fi connectivity.

TMC has separate lecture gallery complex adjacent to the academic building. There are five big lecture gallery having 250-500 seat capacity and each of which are equipped with modern sound system, multimedia projectors, overhead projectors and computers with access to the Internet and Wi-Fi connectivity.

There is also a modern air-conditioned Seminar hall with 400 seat capacity and an exclusive Examination hall.



Medical Skill Center/ Skill lab

There is a Medical Skill Centre in academic building and there is also another Medical Skill Lab in hospital. Students and faculty members can use the Skill lab and Skill center to practice and enhance their technical skills there.



Labs and Museums

TMC has advanced and modernized laboratory facilities for all levels of medical students: Pre-clinical, Para-Clinical and Clinical.



➤ **Pre-Clinical**

Phase I: Anatomy Dissection Hall (Two), Histology Labs (Two) and Museum. Physiology and Biochemistry Labs.

➤ **Para-clinical**

Phase II: Community Medicine Museum, Forensic Medicine Museum.

Phase III Pharmacology Lab, Pathology Lab and Museum, Microbiology Lab and Serology & Immunology, Histopathology & Cytology Lab.

➤ **Clinical**

TMC's teaching hospital having 850 bed and equipped with all modernized equipment and facilities and varieties of profile of cases are admitted here in all



disciplines. Hospital has skill's lab for the skills development of the trainee doctors, nurses, a paramedics and students also. This is a unique facilities among the Government and Non-Government Medical Colleges.

Library

The Central Library at TMC aims to provide support for the Medical College's learning, teaching and research activities. The library supports the curriculum and research needs of the college community through the development of pertinent collections and the provision of services designed to facilitate access to information and learning.

The library houses approximately 5,984 books of 701 titles, 670 local journals, and 176 international journals in its collection and has access to about 80 online journals.

The Central Library is fully air-conditioned with floor area of 7000 sq ft. The library has separate reading areas for students and teachers; it also has e-library facility with both broadband internet and Wi-Fi connectivity. Photocopy facility is also available in the library. Library hour is from 8:00 am to 9:00 pm (or schedule announced by the college authority).



Hospital has its own separate library for its doctors and nurses. Besides, there are libraries in various departments and in hostels. There are separate reading rooms in hostels also.

Accommodation Facilities

TMC has separate hostel facilities for male, female, international & local students and intern doctors. Even it has separate dormitory and family quarter for resident doctors and teachers. All of the hostels have Wi-Fi connectivity. The hostels have common dining area; TV room and Indoor games facilities, with provisions for playing table tennis, carrom, ludo and chess. The hostels also have separate reading room and prayer room.



Canteens and Cafeterias

In the campus of TMC there are several spacious and well-lit Canteens and Cafeterias for students, faculties, doctors and staffs. A variety of snacks, meals and drinks are available in those Canteens and Cafeterias.



Common Rooms

In the academic building of TMC, there have separate common rooms for male and female students with provision for indoor games such as carrom and chess and sufficient seats where students can lounge around and enjoy their leisure period.

There are common rooms in hospital and hostels also.



Wi-Fi connectivity

The whole campus of TMC is covered with Wi-Fi connectivity.

N.B. – Wi-Fi connectivity for students are strictly controlled by TMC authority to maintain proper academic atmosphere in the campus.

Transport facilities

TMC has special transport facilities for the students, staff, and faculty members. It has separate shuttle bus service for the students and faculties from college to downtown.



Medical Education Unit (MEU)

Medical Education Unit (MEU) has been established to ensure Quality Assurance in medical education. The functions of MEU include conducting educational research, arranging workshops, facilitate in students evaluation by teachers and teachers evaluation by students, preparing report on Quality Assurance Scheme quarterly & annually, assist in extra-curricular activities (cultural program, Magazine publication), career development of academic staff etc. The MEU also takes care of upgrading and systematizing the process of student assessment in knowledge, skills and attitudinal aspects. By providing specialized resources for teaching, service and a focus on educational research, it is essential to the continued development of medical education as a discipline. The annual report of Colleges is also prepared by MEU and further Academic improvement has been done accordingly by this unit.



Workshop and Training

Workshops and trainings on Teaching Methodology and Research Methodology have been arranged regularly as a part of Faculty Development Scheme.

Orientation program of teachers about Quality Assurance Scheme has been arranged on regular basis.

Class and Examination monitoring and supervision

Tutorial and Practical classes are regularly monitored and supervised by the Professors to maintain quality education.

Examination Review Committee is also functioning.

Academic Calendar

One of the unique features of TMC is its Academic Calendar. Date wise Everyday class topic, type of class, internal examination date and leave information is mentioned in the Academic Calendar, which will help students in planning their academic activities.

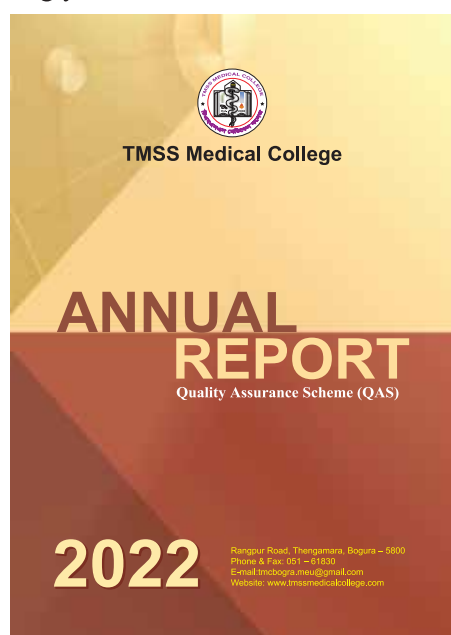
TMSS Medical College Journal (TMCJ) is published biannually. In 2022, 19th issue of journal has been published.

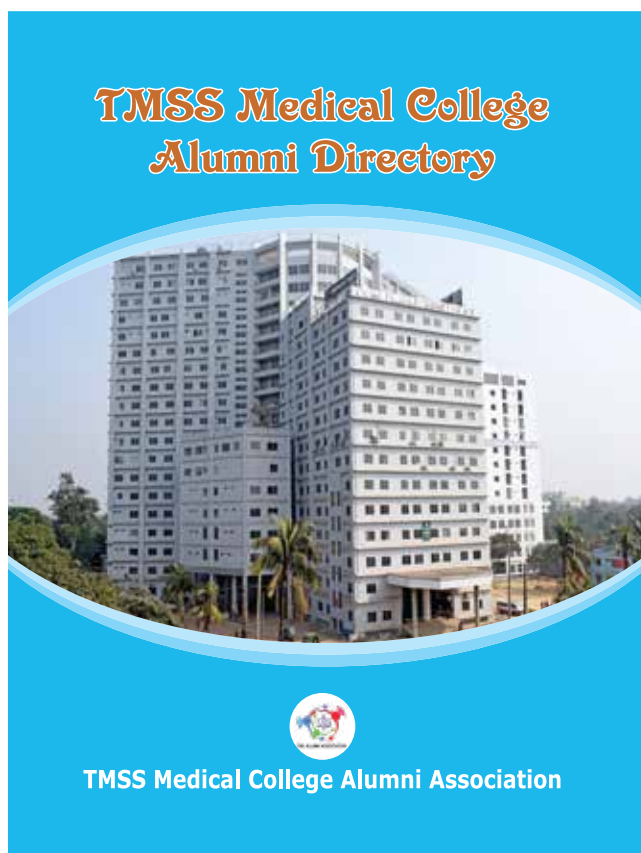

Seminar, Conference and Webinar

Central Seminar (fortnightly), Conference, Webinar, Integrated Teaching are arranged regularly with participation of local and international faculty. Besides, Topic Discussion and presentations are practiced in respective departments.



Feedback from Faculty, Student and External Examiner

Evaluation and suggestions of the faculty members has been collected through the prescribed Personal Review form and steps are taken accordingly for continuous development of faculty as well as educational environment.

Phase wise evaluation by students is carried out and necessary steps are taken accordingly to enhance teaching-learning experience as well as overall environment of TMC.

External Examiner's report has been collected according to the prescribed format and steps are taken according to their valuable opinions.

Student Guidance/Counseling

Proper Institutional guidance is still essential in all educations particularly in medical science to meet challenges of the world. Teachers are always keen to provide such guidance. A small group of students is placed under a teacher to help and guide students in academic matters like studies, examination, attendance etc. Students are advised to meet their Guide Teacher them-selves or whenever asked by the Guide Teacher.

TMC has also formed a Central Counseling Committee to improve academic activities of weak and irregular students. The Committee is functioning with regular monthly meeting. Counseling is designed to facilitate student achievement, find effective solutions to their daily problems, improve student behavior and attendance, and help students develop academically and socially.

Sending Academic Reports to Guardians

One of the unique features of TMC is that, students' Academic reports are prepared and sent to guardians quarterly (in every three months). Thus, the guardians can monitor the progress of their children.

Apart from that, information of students' academic, administrative or other issues are sent to guardians whenever necessary.

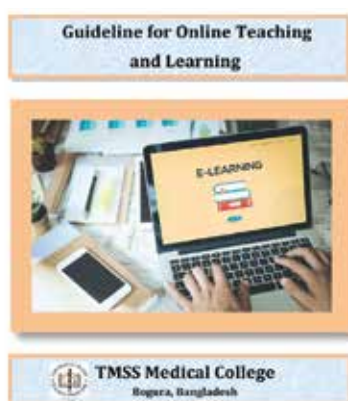
Annual Parents Meeting

Annual Parents Meeting is organized each year with the presence of the parents of Bangladeshi and International students separately. In the meeting the guardians and TMC authority can share information, knowledge and experiences.



Online Classes during COVID-19 Pandemic

Due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus, all academic activities are suspended and students are staying at their home in Bangladesh and abroad (international students). In this situation, TMC has started "Online classes" to continue the academic activities which will ensure that the students are not detached from their study and will also ensure them to be in the right path for upcoming examinations. For TMC, it will help the institution to secure good results as before. Besides, the step of taking online classes will further enhance the goodwill of this institution as one the prominent medical colleges in Bangladesh.



Internship Program

After passing final professional MBBS examination students have to enroll for one year log book guided rotatory internship program in respective teaching field of which 15 days placement is made at rural level at Upazilla Health Complex. Internship program is structured and supervised. It is compulsory to complete Internship Training Program designed by Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council (BM&DC) to get permanent registration for doing independent practice.

Post-graduate Training Programs

TMSS Medical College & Rafatullah Community Hospital (TMC & RCH) has post-graduate training facilities for Medicine, Surgery, Pediatrics, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Radiology & Imaging and Anesthesiology disciplines which are recognized by Bangladesh College of Physicians and Surgeons (BCPS). Recently Ophthalmology, ENT, Orthopaedics and Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery are also recognized by BCPS for post-graduate training. After completing the undergraduate MBBS course, interested doctors need to complete post-graduate training in specific field of interest as a requirement of doing post-graduation course like post-graduate diplomas, MD and FCPS in specialized fields.

Co-Curricular Activities

It is not obligatory that learning can only occur in the classroom. TMC authority strongly believes that Co-curricular Activities can also play a significant role to develop well learned professionals and can also play critical role in the process of enhancing student's college career. Thus, College emphasizes to the different kinds of co-curricular activities i.e. sports, students week etc. along with the academic activities. A brief summary of co-curricular activities have mentioned in the following section. The students also participate in social welfare activity through medicine club, TMSS blood donation club (TBDC), photographic club, cultural club, debate club etc.



Student Week

Every year TMC arrange a weeklong celebration of sports and cultural competition among the students, staff and faculties. As a part of extracurricular activities TMC initiates several sport activities in a calendar year. Namely Students week Celebration, inter & Intra institute Foot-ball and cricket tournament, native sports activities during various national day celebrations.



Special Day Observance

Every year according to the calendar, Special Days are celebrated and observed with active participation of the students and faculties, like Bengali New Year Celebration, Independence Day Celebration, Victory Day Celebration, World Health Day Celebration etc.

Performance evaluation system

In-course Examinations:

Students are expected to maintain a consistently high standard in the academic performance. In-course evaluations will be made through regular periodic item card tests, assignments, card final and term final examination and comprehensive assessment conducted by individual departments. The term examination shall include written (combinations of MCQs, SAQ) Oral, Practical/Clinical including OSPE and OSCEs. The result shall be recorded in students progress report card/log book of which ten percent (10%) of marks

of each subject in the University Professional Examinations shall come from scores obtained in in-course formative evaluations known as Formative Assessment (FA). No student shall be allowed to sit for professional MBBS examination of the university unless he/she attends a minimum of 75% of classes held, secure at least 60% marks in all class assignments and periodic in-course examinations and demonstrates satisfactory attitude, behavior and conduct and has paid all dues of college and University.

Eligibility for Appearing in the Professional Examination:

1st, 2nd & 3rd Terms are completed * Certificate from the respective head of the department responding students obtaining at least 75% attendance in all classes (Lecture, practical, tutorial, residential field practice, clinical placement etc.) during the phase.

* Obtaining at least 60% Marks in formative Examination.

* No student shall be allowed to appear in the professional examination unless the student passes in all the subjects of the previous professional examination separately.

Pass Marks:

Pass marks is 60 %. Student shall have to pass written (SBA & MTF-MCQ+SEQ+SAQ+Formative), Oral, Practical and Clinical examination separately.

ADMISSION

Bangladeshi Students

Eligibility Criteria for Admission in MBBS and BDS Course (for Bangladeshi Students)

- The students have to apply for national admission test with the requisite merit score of SSC and HSC or equivalent examinations.
- After the admission test, national merit and eligible list for MBBS and BDS Admission will be published by Directorate General of Medical Education, Dhaka. Students, who have been in eligible merit list, can apply for admission after the circular from DGME.
- Eligible students will be admitted in the Medical College on merit basis among the applicants.
- Reserve seats for the FF (Freedom Fighter) and tribal candidates will be followed as per Government rule.
- Admission of Poor & Meritorious quota will be taken as per Government rule.

Admission Procedures

- All Procedure of admission to private medical college will be conducted by the Directorate General of Medical Education (DGME). DGME will publish Admission notice in the national newspaper and also in the website of DGME. Students who get 40 above marks in admission test can apply.
- From the national merit list, students, who wishes to admit in the private medical colleges, have to apply online again to DGME. During application, students have to give choices for private medical colleges.
- From merit position and given choices, student will be selected for certain medical college and will be notified by DGME through SMS and a college wise list of selected students will be published. Within maximum 5 days selected student will have to give confirmation to his/her selection to certain medical college.
- For Poor and Meritorious quota, Students should apply online to DGME during the application procedure and these students will not be considered for general quota.

International Students

Eligibility Criteria for Admission in MBBS and BDS Course (for International Students)

1. SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2019.
2. HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2021.
3. Minimum aggregate GPA in SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent and HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent Examination: **7.00 (seven)**. In addition, the students from India and Nepal have to follow the rules & regulations for admission in abroad. (Qualify in the entrance exams of the respective Medical Council (i.e.-NEET for India etc.) and thereby have a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from respective Medical Council.)
4. Minimum GPA either in SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent or in HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent Examination: **3.00 (three)**.
5. Minimum GP in Biology: **4.00**.
6. For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent examination, only top 5 subjects are considered for calculation of GPA. Therefore, GPA in 'O' level = (total marks obtained in top five subjects)/ 5.
7. For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent examination, only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered for calculation of GPA. Therefore, GPA in 'A' level = (total marks obtained in three subjects)/ 3.
8. After fulfillment of the Criteria mentioned in the Guideline, student can apply for admission in MBBS course.

Admission Guidelines

- ☐ Bangladesh High commission office in different foreign countries publishes the admission advertisement for the foreign students in respective countries.
- ☐ The Foreign students have to collect the application form, filled up duly and submit the high commission office with all necessary papers.
- ☐ The students have to collect equivalent certificate through high commission office.
- ☐ International students must have to submit the Equivalence Certificate Issued by DGHS, Bangladesh to the college. (In Original)
- ☐ Foreign students must have to submit the Certificates and Mark transcripts of SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent and HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent Examination. (In Original)
- ☐ Foreign students must bear the student visa, without student visa no student should be admitted.
- ☐ The students have to comply with the rules and regulations of respective Medical Council for admission in abroad.
- ☐ Foreign students and parents must sign the pre-admission guidelines of TMC.
- ☐ Booking Money – USD 3000 for MBBS and USD 2000 for BDS. Booking money should be paid against individual students. If any student fails to admit after sending booking money, his booking should be considered as cancelled and the booking money will be forfeited.
- ☐ The total amount of the admission fee (USD 18,000 for MBBS/ USD 8,000 for BDS for the session 2022-23) must be paid before admission; otherwise admission would not be completed. The next installments must be paid in due time as mentioned in the fee structure. If any student fails to pay the installment in due time, they will be fined \$1 for each day.
- ☐ This fee structure is exclusively for 5 (Five) years. If any student fails to come out successful during a regular period of 5 years or his/her study time is extended, then after 5 years the monthly tuition fees, hostel charges (for food and accommodation) and other charges (if any) shall be borne by the student. The tuition fee will be USD 120 per month and the hostel charges (for food and accommodation) will be as per the regular hostel charges for the foreign students.
- ☐ In addition to the course fees, students will have to pay the four university exam fees (Approximately USD 160/ per exam), fees for Residential Field Site Training & Study tour (Approximately USD 350). For personal expenses foreign student may need USD 100 per month approximately. This is out of Fee Structure.
- ☐ If any student wishes to get Internship allowance on Internship training program in TMSS Medical College & Rafatullah Community Hospital, the student has to pay 2,200 (Two thousand & Two Hundred) at the time of admission (Refundable).
- ☐ During internship training, intern student will be accommodated in the Intern hostel, hostel fees (food cost, utility bill etc.) will be borne by the student. Food menu for the Intern hostel may vary from the Student hostel.

Cancellation Policy of Admission

If any student wants to cancel his/ her admission before registration to the University, he has to pay the admission fee as IC (Institutional Compensation). But after registration to the University, he/she has to pay the total course fee as IC (Institutional Compensation).

FSD along with college administration provide highest care to newly admit foreign students' related academic support to facilitate teaching in their class.

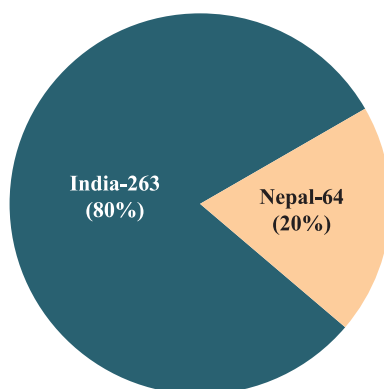

FSD regularly meets the foreign students concerning their study and other problems. One Professor is responsible for this desk as Head and the information is given below for easy communication.

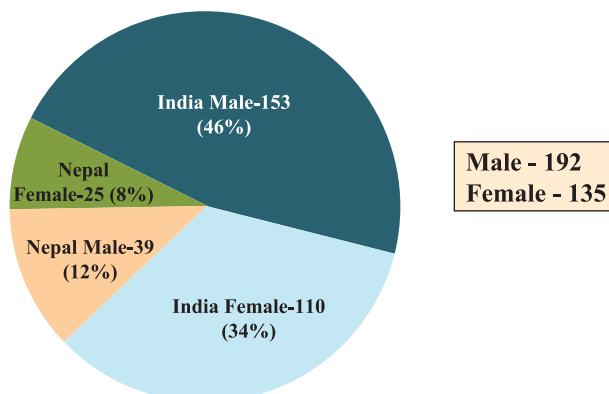

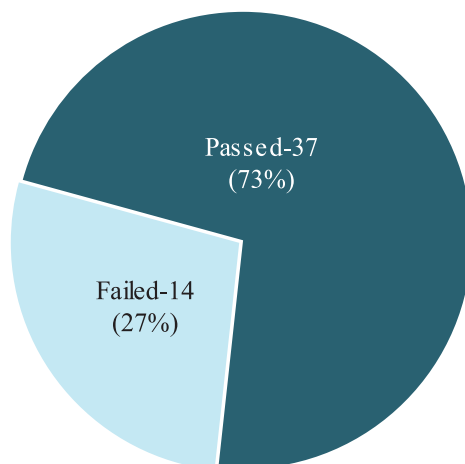


Gender wise Students Breakdown

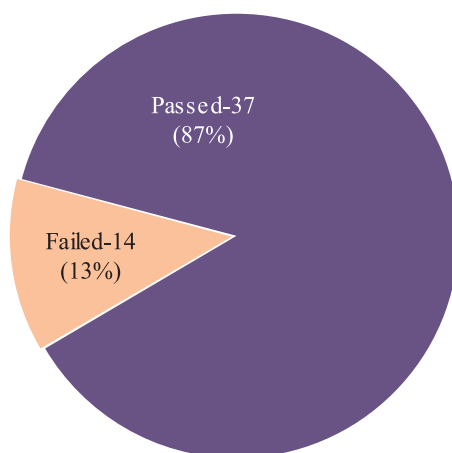

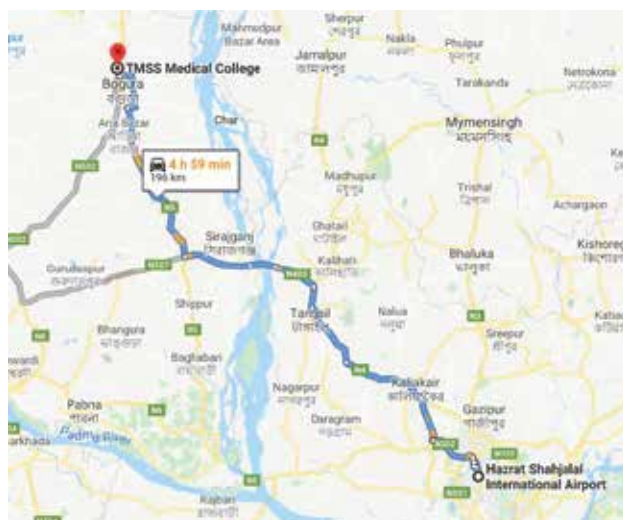

Code of Conduct for the Students



Dress Code

Every student attending lectures, tutorial & practical classes or hospital duty must put on proper dress for boys, loose shirts, pants properly laced shoes & long white coat. For ladies, salwar, kammeez, dupatta & the long white coat are recommended. All type of shorts and slippers are not allowed.

General Rules

- ☐ Students will be residents of male or female hostels. College Authority will arrange their necessary belonging from the office of the hostel Superintendent. Musical instruments, heater, TV, refrigerator or cooking device are not allowed in room and the entire campus is a no smoking zone.
- ☐ Students should carry their identity card while they are inside the College and Hospital.
- ☐ Students should attend classes with well dress & white apron.
- ☐ Fashionable dress, cosmetics, untidy hair, slippers are discouraged in the college & hospital campus.
- ☐ Postering and wall writing in the college and hospital premises are prohibited. Those are considered as act of indiscipline and those involved are liable to punishment.
- ☐ All types of demonstrations, processions, shouting in the college and hospital premises are prohibited and students involved in those activities are liable to punishment.
- ☐ Absences from classes, individuals or in a mass without permission are punishable by imposing of daily fine individually. Guardians will be informed of such acts.

College Discipline

Students must observed strict discipline in the college. On disciplinary grounds the following penalties may be imposed on a student, depending on the nature of offence:

- ☐ Warning ☐ Fines ☐ Expulsion from hostel ☐ Defer from appearing examinations
- ☐ Any other punishment suggested by academic/disciplinary council ☐ Removed name from college register

Compulsory Hostel Rules

1. Without any written permission from the relevant authority, no furniture/ luggage/ bag/ cartoon can be taken in / out from hostel. No change or damage can be done to the room fittings. Using/Keeping electric heater or any sort of cooker in hostel rooms is strictly prohibited. Any appliances used for cooking cannot be kept in the rooms.
2. No provision of appointment of personal Aya or any supporting personnel. Everyone should ensure that their own room, adjacent corridor and toilet are cleaned. There must be waste paper basket in every room and waste should be disposed in designated places. Nothing should be thrown away (within or outside hostel premise) through door or window.
3. Students are solely responsible for taking care of their personal belongings in hostel.
4. All sorts of fees should be paid regularly.
5. Night halt outside the hostel without prior permission from the proper authority is strictly prohibited.
7. Allotted room can't be changed without permission of the proper authority & can't be given to others for staying.
6. Students are not permitted to hold any kind of meetings or gatherings in the hostel premises. Any sort of activities, which will hamper the hostel environment, hamper others study or create annoyance of other students, are completely prohibited.
7. No student is permitted to keep or use any illegal/prohibited/illegitimate/dangerous substance in the hostel room. Using television, fridge or similar appliances in the room are prohibited.
8. Breakfast will be available from 7:00 am to 10:00 am, Lunch from 1:30 pm to 4:00 pm and dinner from 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm.
9. The main gates of the hostels will be closed at 10:00 pm. After that, no student will be allowed to enter/ leave the hostel. On special cases, students may enter/ leave the hostel after taking permission from the Hostel Superintendent/Higher Authority.
10. No student is allowed to enter/ leave the campus after 8:30 pm in the winter (October to March) and after 9:30 pm in the summer (April to September).

11. Guardians/father/mother/brother/sister can meet with the resident in the visiting room only within the visiting hours (in the winter-October to March- 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm and in the summer -April to September- 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm). No visitors can be taken to the room. Every visitor should make the certain entries in the visitor's book, which is kept with the guard of the hostels.
12. After passing the Final Professional MBBS/ BDS examination, seat allotment will be forfeited and he/ she must leave the hostel within 07 (seven) days and would collect clearance certificate from the authority. Otherwise after the mentioned time, authority could be allotted those seats to the interested students.
13. The college or hostel authorities reserve the right to visit/inspect any room at any time and also to change/ cancel allotted seats whenever necessary/ impose fine or to take disciplinary actions, if found violating hostel rules.
14. To pet animal is totally prohibited in Hostel.

Dining Rules

15. Students are not allowed to enter the kitchen, take any items from the kitchen and cooking food in the kitchen.
16. Everyone must take food according to the selected menu provided by the authority. No one is allowed to forcefully take extra food.
17. Taking food to the room is strictly prohibited and, also, no crockeries (glass, plate, jug etc.) could be taken to the room from the dining area.

Action should be taken according to Hostel Disciplinary Rules, if found any discrepancy mentioned in above.

Rules and Regulations for the Foreign Students

General

All foreign students must comply with the rules & regulations of TMSS Medical College. Any violation of the college rules and discipline are liable to punishment or even cancellation of their admission.

- ☐ All students have to bear college ID Card in College Campus and outside of campus.
- ☐ All Students must submit their passport after travelling in college office and they can't leave campus without permission of Principal.
- ☐ They must use college bus for going to town/ market & coming from town/ market.
- ☐ Authority will not be accountable for any student who will leave the campus without prior information /permission from the proper college authority. If the student fails to carry out the leave rules he/she must be under disciplinary actions depending on the circumstances. In case of major violation of rules, the academic council of college can take any action.
- ☐ The students will come back to campus with a letter from the guardians.
- ☐ The student must update their guardians contact regularly.
- ☐ All passports of foreign students will be preserved in the administration office. After approval of leave from the authority, students can collect passport from the administration office. Foreign students must submit the passport to the administration office within 24 hours after arrival from leave.
- ☐ For Visa extension he/she should submit application with fee at least 3 months before of Visa expiry.
- ☐ For leaving campus Indian students must collect departure certificate from local SP office.

Hostel

Hostel rules are same for all students.

Leaving college campus

- ☐ Foreign Students can leave the campus when regular vacation would be announced by TMSS Medical College and they must come back to the Hostel within the time limit of vacation.
- ☐ In addition every foreign student has to submit leave application to Principal, TMSS Medical College through Hostel Super in genuine ground.
- ☐ For medical leave, he/she must submit recent medical certificate from concerned doctor (not below Assistant Professor) of TMSS Medical College Hospital.
- ☐ In case of permissible issue or other unavoidable reasons for leave, he/she must submit a written statement from the parent/ guardian.
- ☐ Every student/guardian should send a message/mail after reaching his/her home safely.
- ☐ Before returning from home, the students/ guardians should send a message/mail mentioning the expected date and time of arrival at TMC.
- ☐ For student loan or extension of passport validity he/she should submit appropriate documents at least one month before departure.
- ☐ No leave application will be granted during any type of exam, unless in emergency condition.

Background

TMSS Medical College and Rafatullah Community Hospital (TMC & RCH) is a focal point of TMSS Health Sectors. Rafatullah Community Hospital (RCH) was established in the year 1995 at Thengamara village by Professor Dr. Hosne- Ara Begum the founding Executive Director of TMSS through the financial assistance of Terre des Homes- Netherlands. It has been launched with the dream and theme to deliver health care services to the poor and rural people of Northern Bangladesh at an affordable cost. In the first phase in 1995, a 10 bed hospital was put into service. In 2008, as per conditions of Medical College operational policy, this hospital has been emerged as 250-bedded with a new name “TMSS Medical College and Rafatullah Community Hospital (TMC & RCH)” to facilitate clinical education. The number of beds has been increased to 850. It is equipped with most modern instruments and facilities, offering round the clock services including emergencies, for indoor as well as outdoor patients. In its final and ultimate phase of completion, the hospital will have 1000 beds to provide all aspects of medical and surgical services in its own 19 storied building.

Presently this hospital provides General treatments to patients through OPD and IPD services, specialized health services, Mother and Child healthcare services, EPI & Family Planning Services, Major and Minor surgical operations, Radiology and Pathology services. Specialized and Graduate Doctors provide good quality healthcare services round the clock at low cost/cost subsidy/free of cost especially for poor and extreme poor patients. Beside these, the hospital provides instant medical treatments to the casualty (accidental, injured) patients through its emergency management unit.

The hospital also provides practical learning facilities to the students those who are studying at various medical educational institutes under TMSS Health Sector.

Operation Theaters

COVID-19 and TMC & RCH

The Corona virus (COVID-19) pandemic has been emerged as global health crisis in recent time. Since emergence it continues to take a massive toll on human health along with so many parts of life. Considering the COVID-19 alarming situation, TMSS being a Non-Profit Organization in Bangladesh has taken a number of initiatives to support the National Response Plan of the Government of Bangladesh in its fight against COVID-19 outbreak. Among the initiatives, TMSS has commenced hospital level activities through TMC & RCH, has established PCR lab and successfully started COVID-19 test and, moreover, it provides specialized treatments to the COVID-19 patients. The details of the hospital level activities are as follows:

- ❑ Arranged separate entrance-exit, separate OPD for patients with fever cough sore throat, established Respiratory Unit in Medicine Ward and ensured other services are opened at 850 Bed TMSS Medical College and Hospital.
- ❑ Launched exclusive Hand Wash Corners at all entrance point of TMSS offices, hospitals/ sub clinics and Liquid Disinfectant is being sprayed in surrounding areas of TMSS office and hospital premises on regular basis.
- ❑ Established IT supported 20 Bed Isolation Ward, 2 Beds ICU and Quarantine Centre with 36 Bed facilities in Bogura Sadar and Shajahanpur Upazila.
- ❑ Assigned 200 Medical Professionals (doctors & nurses) of TMSS Hospital has been given proper orientation, training for management of suspected COVID-19 patients and Isolation Ward under the purview of government instructed treatment protocol and patient referral system.
- ❑ Making of Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) & Mask by TMSS Handicrafts and collects PPE, Gloves, Goggles and Sanitizers from other sources for the Medical Professionals of TMSS for providing medical treatment.
- ❑ TMSS Mobile Health Service Medical Team maintaining proper protection provides treatment to the patients to the Sub-centre of TMSS in the community with chronic diseases referred by Medical Assistant of TMSS.
- ❑ RT PCR Lab Setup.
- ❑ TMSS Health Service Medical Team also provides on call Home Care Service to the patients with chronic diseases not able to come to the hospital for routine checkup.
- ❑ Ensured 24 hours Pharmacy and Ambulance service for patients and Accommodation with Food & Transportation facilities for Doctors and other Medical Professionals.
- ❑ Introduced online reporting cell for providing information of cough, fever patients as per District Civil Surgeon Office prescribed format.
- ❑ Introduced hotline number (01711436508, 01730017142) of 850 Bed TMSS Hospital for providing health service assistance.

TMSS Health Sector has been working to develop all its programs and institutes as a Centre of Excellence for integrated healthcare delivery system that providing Primary, Secondary and Tertiary level medical treatment and healthcare services and medical education in different level with a strong social commitment to build-up Medical Professionals as like Doctors, Nurses & Diploma Technologists and nurture the community through promotion of Health Education and Medical Research.

TMSS Medical College, Dental Unit, the hospital, the nursing college and a good number of diploma institutes have been established under the TMSS Health Sector, offering medical education & research, hospital care as well as training in nursing service.

The health campus is situated in Thengamara village of Sadar Thana under Bogura district. Thengamara is about 5 km north of Bogura city. It is connected by Dhaka-Rangpur Highway.

In the 1st phase in 1998 a 10 Bed Maternity Hospital, called Rafatullah Community Hospital, was established with the vision of providing health care services for the poor and marginalized people of the local rural community. At present the hospital, with more than 850 Beds, is providing tertiary level services of all aspects of medical, surgical or emergency requirements including ICU & CCU, NICU and Trauma management. 250 bedded TMSS Cancer Center and TMSS Biomolecular lab are other notable establishments of TMSS Health Sector.

TMSS has another commitment to facilitate the rural poor and underprivileged people through integrated health-care services who have lack of access to health facilities in all over the country. It also promotes medical, para-medical and nursing education. TMSS has another goal to establish sustainable health-care services through Public-Private partnership and Community participation.

For integrated and comprehensive development, TMSS has established and is practicing a development Model called HEM that means Health, Education and Micro-finance through a single branch. For fulfilling the beneficiary's health needs, it establishes Sub-clinics in different parts of Bangladesh.

Overview of Thengamara Mohila Sabuj Sangha (TMSS)



TMSS was established decades back in 1964 with its indigenous title ‘Thengamara Sabuj Sangha’ (TSS) at a village named Thengamara under Sadar Upazila of Bogura District with the approval of Department of Social Welfare. During the great war of liberation of Bangladesh, all the documents of TSS were burnt out and functions stopped. Subsequently in 1980 the TSS Authority expressed their inability and incapability to run the organization and decided to hand it over to Prof. Dr. Hosne Ara Begum legally and with full authority to run the show thence forward. Prof. Dr. Hosne Ara Begum reformed TSS as TMSS by an amendment resolution which incorporated the Bengali term “Mohila” keeping of the Board. TSS of 1964 thus got subsumed into TMSS in 1980, with Prof. Dr. Hosne Ara Begum becoming the Founder Chief Executive Officer; TMSS has been on the development train since then till today under her discreet mentoring. Whatever socio-economic advancement has been achieved and vast beneficiaries across the country served with multifarious programs along the lines of TMSS cherished Goal and Objectives can be well attributed to her caring approach, dynamic leadership and prudent guidance. In needs mention here that the main reason behind incorporation the Bengali word “Sabuj” in the revised and remodeled organization styled TMSS has been the motto of green revolution in rural Bangladesh.
